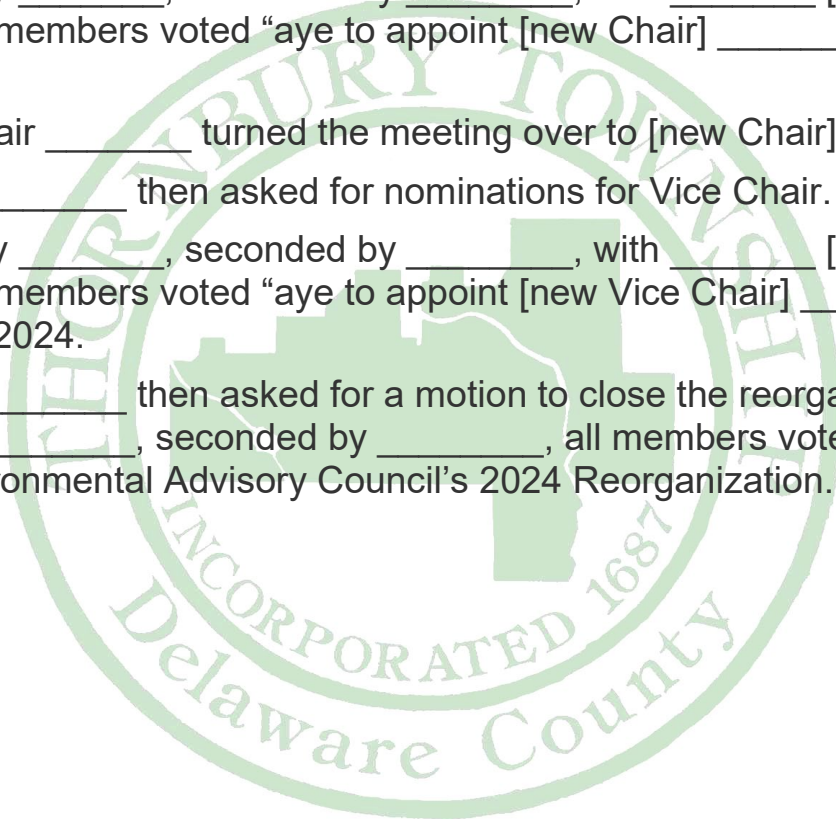

- Make recommendations as to the possible use of open land areas of the Township of Thornbury.
- Promote a community environmental program.
- Maintain an index of all open areas, publicly or privately owned including, but not limited to, flood prone areas, wetlands and other unique natural areas.
- Advise the appropriate local governmental agencies in the acquisition of property, both real and personal.
- Undertake such other environmental tasks as requested by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Thornbury.

The EAC meets on the third Thursday of each month on the Ground Floor of the Township Building. Township residents are welcome to attend.
