### Thornbury Township Board of Supervisors Public Meeting Wednesday, July 21, 2021

The Thornbury Township Board of Supervisors held a Public Meeting, Wednesday July 21, 2021, hosted at the Township Administration Building, 6 Township Drive, Cheyney PA. Chairman Raith called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with a salute to the flag.

#### **APPROVAL OF CHECK REGISTERS**

On a motion by James Kelly, seconded by James Raith, and carried unanimously, the General Fund check register in the amount of \$128,133.80, for the period June 17, through July 21, 2021, was approved. Chairman Raith called for comment. There was none.

#### **TOWNSHIP MANAGER'S REPORT- Jeff Seagraves**

Jeff reported we received half of the money from DCED for the American Recovery Plan and mentioned utilizing those funds for a possible sewer extension.

The business that was cited for operation at 27 Sweetwater Road has continued to disregard the Cease-and-Desist order that was issued. Our special counsel, Jim Byrne, submitted an emergency injunction. We have a conference call with the Judge for the case tomorrow.

The appeal to the Zoning Hearing Board for 35 Locksley Road was held on July 12, 2021. The Zoning Hearing board has scheduled a decision to be announced on Monday August 2, 2021. We are continuing to work with Paychex on the updating of our Personnel Policy. We hope to have this completed before the end of the year.

Our Annual Crab fest is scheduled for this Friday, July 23, 2021, at 6:00 at Thornbury Park. Plans for Founder's Day to be held on September 11, 2021, are continuing.

There was a sewer overflow at the WAWA on 202 which is in our West Side Sewer District. The problem was resolved by WAWA, but we are working to schedule a meeting to avoid any future problems. Chairman Raith requested documentation and Vice Chairman Kelly asked if any residents were affected. Jeff said there were not. The Board thanked Jeff.

Ken then reported on small cell antenna legislation and associated limited fees and he will update the Board in the future. Chairman Raith asked Ken to stay up on that. The Board thanked Ken.

Township Solicitor, Kenneth D. Kynett Esquire, files the following report for July 21st, 2021:

- 1. <u>35 Locksley Road Zoning Violation</u> Attended Zoning Hearing on appeal/application of May 12, 2021 Notice of Violation with Township Manager. The Hearing was held in the lower chapel at Glen Mills School. It was heavily attended by neighboring property owners. The immediate property owners appeared almost unanimously in opposition to the applicant's desire to legally establish and expand the concert and related activities on the property. The applicant stated that the ultimate number of intended concert goers was 400+. There seemed to be some level of apprehension among many of these neighbors to speak out publicly or have their identities known to the applicant. The Hearing closed. The Zoning Hearing Board now has 45 days to render its decision.
- 2. <u>Governor's Declaration Of Disaster Emergency</u> The Declaration of Disaster Emergency enacted by the Governor on March 6, 2020 (as extended) was terminated by the State Legislature on June 10, 2021. As of 12:01 pm on June 29<sup>th</sup>, mandatory mask wearing was ended. As a result, the Township's companion Declaration automatically terminated on June 10<sup>th</sup>, as well.

In addition, the provisions of Act 15 of 2020, allowing for remote meetings also terminated. This means that the Township will have to conduct meetings in person and allow for public participation. It may also offer a "hybrid" form of meeting which would provide for additional interactive public participation by video conference platforms similar to those used while the Declaration was effective.

#### 3. New Legislation:

- (a) **Meeting Agendas.** Act 65 of 2021 amends the Sunshine Act to require the Township to post a meeting agenda containing all items that will be voted on at least 24 hours before the meeting. The agenda must be posted on the Township website and the Township Building and meeting place. Agendas must be available for the public at the meeting place. Unadvertised items may be added if agreed to by a majority vote of the Board. An explanation for changes to the agenda must be announced before the vote the amended agenda must be posted on the Township website <u>and</u> at the Township Building no later than the first business day following the meeting at which the agenda was changed. These requirements would apply to all boards and commissions/committees within the Township. Act 65 is effective on August 29, 2021 and will need to be followed beginning with the September public meetings.
- (b) **Small Cell Wireless Facilities**. Act 50 of 2021, effective on August 29, 2021:
  - Preserves local zoning authority of "small wireless facilities" in Township rights-of-way.
  - Increases fees the Township may charge for applications and recurring right-of-way occupation and ties them to the fee structure set by the FCC.
  - Allows the Township to increase its fees if costs in approving and managing these facilities are higher than the revenue generated by the fees charged.
  - Allows the Township to enact written design standards to minimize aesthetic impact, including limiting new structure height to 50'.
  - Provides Township with 60 days to review applications for existing structures and 90 days for new structures.
  - Applies to both public utility and non-public utility wireless providers.

The Board should consider amendments to the Zoning Code to include the regulations authorized by the Act.



# REPORT OF THE ENGINEER July Supervisor's Meeting July 21, 2021

#### Work completed for the period:

Grading and Road Encroachment Permits – Reviewed several plans for grading and road encroachment. Construction inspections continue.

Planning Commission – Continued working with members on Ordinances and Subdivisions.

Subdivision & Land Development Plans:

Lawler Subdivision - Awaiting revised plans.

Daniels Subdivision – 425 Thornton Rd – 2 Lots – Conditional Final approval granted in 2016. Awaiting updated recording plans and agreements for signature.

15 Tanguy Road – 2,400 SF Accessory Structure Land Development – Revised plans received in late June, and updated review issued. Applicant requested PC to table for July and review in August when they have some more information.

VMDT – Dilworthtown Road – Reviewed Zoning paperwork with Township Officials. Awaiting Subdivision / Land Development submission for complete review.

#### Ordinances:

Sign Ordinance – PC forwarded ordinance to the Supervisors for consideration.

Plant Materials List – Reviewed current Township Ordinance Plant Materials List and issued our Landscape Architect's recommendations for exclusions due to local blights and diseases. Reviewed with the Planning Commission in May. PC forwarded list changes to the Supervisors for consideration.

Crane Property – 24 Lot Subdivision – Roadway curb, stone, base course paving and binder paving has been installed for all roadways. Work continues on stormwater facilities, utilities, retaining walls, site, and multiple home lots. Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 23, & 24 homes are now occupied. House construction continues on Lots 12 & 22. Review of conversion of existing temporary CO's to Permanent CO's are ongoing.

Black Bell Farm (Walton Lane) – 15 lot subdivision – Lots 1-14 (All new homes) are now occupied. Per developer's request, an updated Punch List was issued on 5-7-2021 (originally issued 7-23-2020). Awaiting corrections and paperwork for dedication. Engineering Inspector to walk site with developer to ensure site deficiencies are properly scheduled for repair.

Guilday Site – Lots 1-5 houses are occupied with Temporary CO's. Request for final inspection received in June and a Final Punch list was issued to the developer on 7-15-2021. Awaiting corrections and closeout paperwork.

Sunoco Logistics – Sunoco has completed all piping and valve work. Awaiting Final Restoration and request for final inspection.

NPDES MS-4 Program – 2018 Pollutant Reduction Plan and 2018 MS-4 permit submitted on September 9, 2017 & September 15, 2017, respectively. Continuing to work with PA DEP on revisions. Detailed updates to the storm sewer and qualifying watershed mapping has been completed to comply

with revision requests from PA DEP. Program is currently under Township review prior to resubmission of mapping.

Thornbury Park Parking Lot Expansion – Trainor Concrete & Paving completed final paving and striping on October 9, 2018. Minor corrections at the site are required to allow for final paperwork submission for closeout. Drainage improvements completed the week of January 7, 2019.

Cheyney University Demolition – Yarnell Building has been demolished. Site has been stabilized. Erosion controls removed. Projects appears to be completed, awaiting final inspection request.

Thornbury Park Rain Garden – Water Quality Improvement Project Grant – PA DEP Grant work must be completed by December 31, 2021. Project is substantially complete. Sign design sent to sign contractor/supplier for review and completion. Contractor notified to perform some maintenance of the basin prior to final acceptance.

Emergency Repairs – Station Road – Emergency storm sewer repairs are all substantially completed. Minor corrections per homeowner's request completed.

Thornbury Pre-School Roof Replacement – Draft plans prepared for slate or synthetic slate alternate bidding. Submitted to Township officials for review and comment.

Forrest Hills Drive – Prepared plans and specifications to be sent out to contractors for pricing and supplied homeowners with such.

Terra Firma Builders – 53-57 Sweetwater Road – Coordination with the Township and applicant on final closeout paperwork and bonding requirements ongoing.

Township Map Update – Working with Township officials to update the Township Map with new subdivisions and overall map corrections.

Salt Shed Structural Evaluation – Coordination ongoing with Township Roadmaster and structural engineer for the structural evaluation of the Township Salt Shed in Thornbury Park.

2021 Road Program – Awarded to Glasgow Inc. for Base Bid and Alts 3 & 4 if needed. Contracts were executed and Contractor scheduled for mid-July start. Slight delay in start due to awaiting final PA DOT approval.

2021 Additional Paving Projects – Awarded to Glasgow Inc. for Base Bid and Alts A. Contracts were executed and Contractor tentatively scheduled for late-July start.

Various Drainage Improvement Projects – Prepared sketch plans and began discussion with Township officials on various drainage improvement projects throughout the Township.

Snow & Ice Contracts – 2 Bids received and opened on June 9, 2021. MOR Construction has been notified of award and request for Bonds and contract document signature pages have been sent out.

Floodplain Reports – Floodplain reports issued to the state for 2019 (office closed in 2020) & 2020 by email and US Mail.





# ENGINEER'S REPORT REGARDING WASTEWATER ISSUES July 21, 2021

#### **East Side District**

#### - Wet Weather Flows to WWTP

• We have discussed with staff a "limited" approach to smoke testing – primarily within the Country Run easement where there are very few lateral connections. We are in the process of soliciting quotes to complete this work. In addition, we are also requesting pricing the procure and install inserts in various manholes identified.

#### - Painting of Aeration Tank 1&2 @ WWTP

• The contractor, J.P. Smith began work on June 24<sup>th</sup>. As of the date of this report, the existing coating within the interior has been removed and the primer coat installed in the first tank. We also were able to further evaluate the condition of the interior. There are a number of "typical" repairs that were common in the previous tanks that also exist here. However, the floor in this tank is in worse condition than the previous tanks. Several holes exist, and much of the steel in the vicinity of the aerators in heavily pitted. We have reviewed this with the contractor and identified the extent and method of repair needed.

#### - Black Bell Farm

• We have received updated as-built plans from the Developer and are in the process of reviewing them.

#### **West Side District**

On Wednesday August 7<sup>Th</sup> the Wawa at the corner of Dilworthtown Road and Route 202 had a sanitary sewer overflow (SSO) on their property. From the discussions with the firm that responded, it appears that the issue may be at least partially related to maintenance of the pump station. A letter has been prepared and will be forwarded to Wawa regarding the incident. We also spoke with the Wawa representative, communicated our concerns and requested a meeting to further review these issues.
